AGENDA ITEM TO BE PRESENTED AT NEXT QUARTLEY MEETING

Change Article 4. GOVERNMENT to read

Section 4.1. Composition

The government of this association shall be vested in the board of directors of one Director of each affiliated club or commercial shop, elected officers of this association and immediate past President of the association. A quorum of the board of directors shall be a direct representative of his/her club or group. No director can represent more than one club or group and voting shall be one vote per club. A club must have a director present at a meeting to vote. Elected/appointed officers will be allowed to vote on behalf of their home club when their director is absent. The President or in his absence, the presiding officer [see section 5 paragraph a. for order of precedence] shall cast the tie breaking vote.

JUSTIFICATION FOR MOTION

The smaller clubs feel that they do not have a fair say in the running of VBA. Even though we have smaller numbers we are still one club as with the larger clubs are one club with more members. Items voted on should be based on each club

Pg 5 Article 4. Field Vice President change paragraph 2 to read

He shall be responsible for conducting a scheduling session prior to the September meeting. An Excel spreadsheet will be sent to each club with State shoot dates and meeting dates on it. Clubs can enter shoot dates. The sheet will be updated as needed to keep all zones in line. At the September meeting the final sheet will be voted on for approval.

David Harry Burpee

David H. Burpee, an Army colonel who retired in 1993 as director of defense information in the Office of the Secretary of Defense, died May 4, 2022 from pancreatic cancer. He was 80. Col. Burpee graduated from the University of Washington in Seattle in 1965. He served as an air defense artillery officer early in his career and later as an information officer and military spokesman. He served as a Ranger advisor to South Vietnamese forces in 1968-1969 and later held command and staff positions, including two assignments with the 2nd Armored Division at Ft. Hood, Texas.

In his final three assignments he was Director of Public Affairs for the US Army Military District of Washington (1987-1989), Chief of Public Information for Allied Command Europe and senior public affairs advisor to the Supreme Allied Commander, Europe (1989-1991) and Director of Defense Information at the Pentagon (1991-1993) where he led operations of the Pentagon press room and was the senior uniformed spokesperson for the Department of Defense. His decorations included the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star, the Defense Superior Service Medal with oak leaf cluster, the NGA Civilian Service Award, and the NGA Distinguished Civilian Service Medal.

After his military career, Col. Burpee joined the National Security Industrial Association as a Vice President for four years and then EduCap, Inc. (at that time the nation's largest provider of private student loans with a portfolio in excess of \$2 billion) as a senior vice president. He returned to government service in 2000 as the public

affairs officer for the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency and remained in that role until retirement in 2009. In 2009 he formed David H. Burpee and Associates, a full-service public affairs consulting firm.

His passions included outdoor hunting and fishing activities as well as community service. In those capacities he was the president over several years of different homeowner's associations, executive vice president of the Virginia Bowhunters Association, president of the Belvoir Bowhunters, president of the DIA Rod & Gun Club, president of the National Geospatial-Intelligence Alumni Association-East chapter and member of the NGAA board of directors.

David Harry Burpee was born at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii on Dec. 7, 1941, about five hours after the attack that "will live in infamy." His education included a master's degree in journalism from the University of Kansas (1974), graduation from the Army Command and General Staff College (1976), and completion of the Army War College in 1986. He lived in Italy, Germany and Belgium while in the Army as well as several locations in the U.S. before moving to Fairfax County, VA in 1985.

Survivors include his wife, Justina Hutchko of Elizabeth, PA.; his brother, Bruce Burpee, of Bellingham, WA; two children, Krista Kehrer of South Riding, VA, and Heather Rafalko of Anchorage, AK; two step-children, Stephen Ruzila of Great Falls, VA, Paul Ruzila of Lake Forest, IL, and five grandchildren.

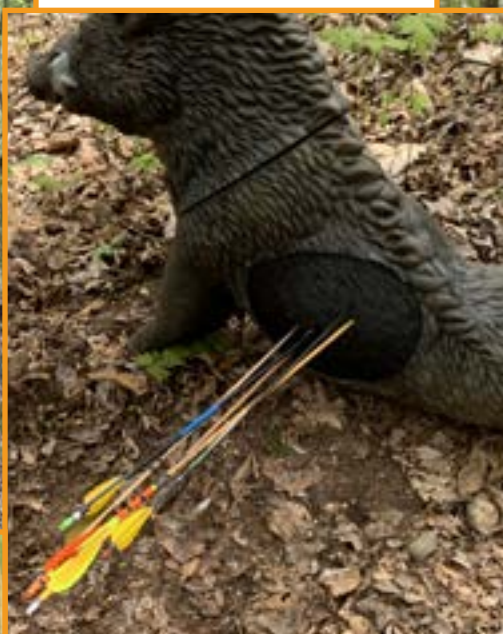
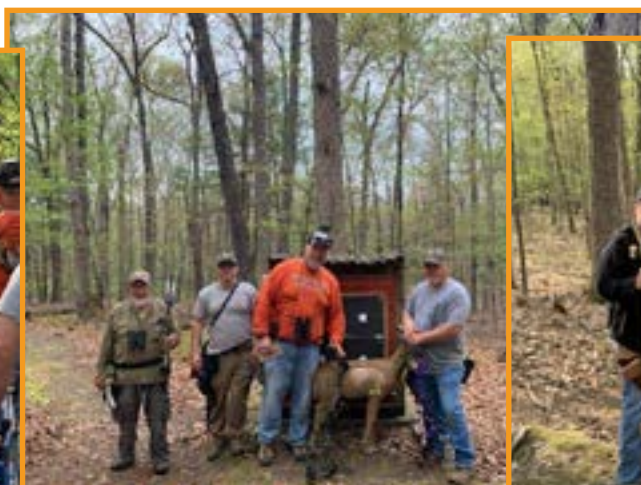

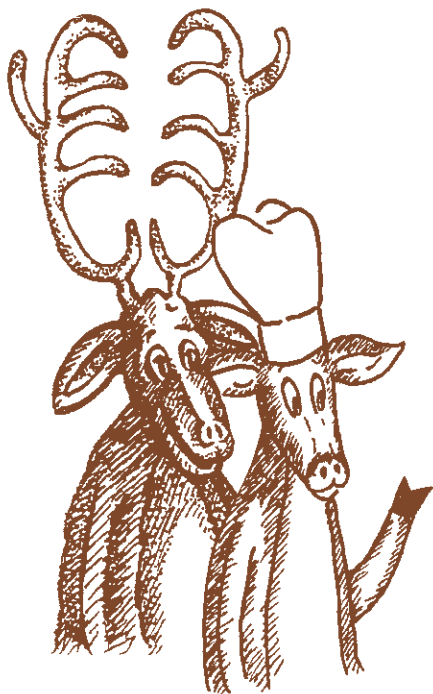

Walley and Winne's Wild Turkey with Morel Mushrooms



Ingredients

- 2 pounds of cleaned turkey breast, sliced crosswise about 1/4 in thick
- 2 cups of fresh morels sliced
- 2 eggs beaten
- 1 cup flour
- 1/4 cup canola oil
- 2 cup Pinot Grigio wine (1 for the Turkey and 1 for you)
- 1/4 cup fresh chopped parsley
- 1 tablespoon of chopped fresh tarragon (or one tsp dried)
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 1/4 cup chicken broth
- 1 lemon cut into quarters for squeezing

Directions

1. Place the seasoned turkey filets in the flour and shake off the excess. Then dip them into the egg mixture.
 2. Preheat the oil in a heavy sauté pan or Dutch oven. Carefully place a few of the egg coated breast filets into the hot oil and slightly brown. Turn and brown the other side and remove and place on a warm platter. Brown the remaining breasts and do the same.
 3. Now take the morels and gently dust them with the remaining flour and fry them until they shrink to half size.
 4. Place all the breasts back into the pan and reduce heat to medium. Add the herbs and salt and pepper.
 5. Deglaze the pan with a little bit of the white wine. If there is some left drink it.
 6. Add the stock and simmer for about 25 minutes until the breasts are tender. The liquid will thicken slightly and make a delicious sauce for topping the breasts.
 7. Squeeze the lemon over the turkey to enhance the flavor.
- I like to serve them with Yukon gold smashed potatoes or rice pilaf.

Conservation Scholarship

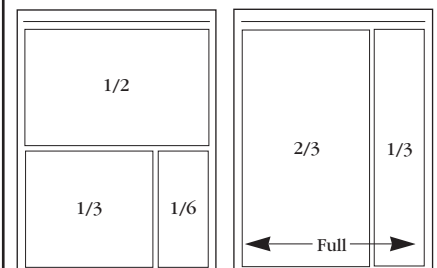

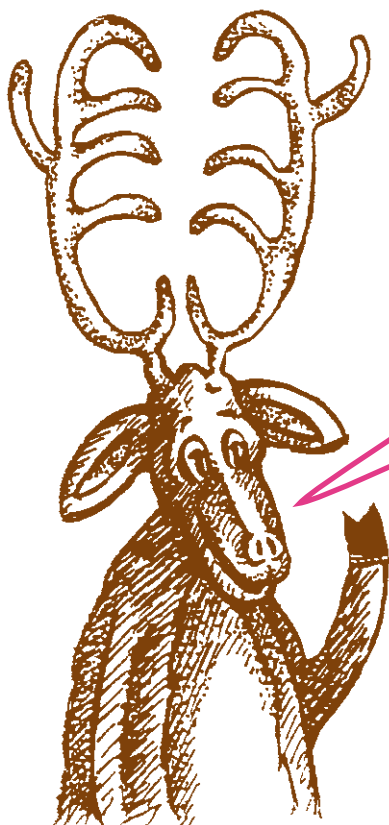

ORDER OF THE GOLDEN FEATHER

NOMINATIONS DUE IN MARCH

The VBA Order of the Golden Feather was created to honor those persons who have given unselfishly of their time and talents toward the betterment of archery and archers. Recipients are persons who possess the virtues of sportsmanship, character, morals, integrity and friendship. As a reflection of the substance for membership, only 86 people have been elected to the Order in the past 78 years.

To be qualified, a candidate must be member in good standing of the VBA at the time of nomination, must have a minimum of ten successive years' membership in the VBA and must be sponsored by three VBA members of good standing or by a VBA Club.

This article is a reminder that candidates must be submitted to the Board of Directors at the March meeting for this year. Nominations must be in writing and be signed by sponsoring individuals or a Club officer. Successful nominees have always performed duties or had an impact outside their immediate club.
