

From the Hunting Vice President

The Hunting Committee has discussed what the VBA focus areas for next year need to be. What does VBA want to fight for in support of bowhunters? Here are the top ideas:

• Contiguous season and harvest rules for Bowhunters: If you choose to bow hunt exclusively (which is clearly a more challenging style of hunting!) VBA would like to see increased opportunity for bowhunters by having one contiguous archery season where the harvest rules are the same throughout the season, meaning deer of either sex would be allowed to be taken through the season. The "contiguous season" would run from the start of the Early Archery Season through the end of the Late Archery Season. The same bag limits would apply. We think this increased opportunity would likely recruit more bowhunters and increase Archery License sales. (Thank you, Danny Korbini, for this idea!)

• In high density deer counties, VA DWR has increased firearms seasons. In these areas, VBA proposes to increase bowhunting opportunities by opening the archery season earlier, as well as allowing antlered deer harvest. Again, VBA thinks this increased opportunity would likely recruit more bowhunters, increase Archery License sales, and provide VA DWR additional population control.

• The Hunting Committee has also discussed the idea of a Spring Bear Season.

The 266th meeting of the Virginia Bowhunters Association was held at Bowhunters of Rockingham Clubhouse on September 17, 2023. The meeting was called to order by President, Shannan Nesselrodt at 8:40 A.M. with eleven Board member representatives of clubs and the President of the Executive Board present (see attached). The pledge of allegiance to the flag was recited and a prayer said.

Minutes of the Previous Meeting

After a show of hands vote, the minutes from previous meeting were not read, However the was a correction made concerning Amber Shifflett's first name originally stated as Ashley.

Officer Reports

Field Vice President

Jim Little reported that participation in State shoots have been low. He brought the awards bags for the shoots next year and asked the club representatives take back to clubs to save postage. The red, white, and blue state pins were divided among the clubs to use as they wished.

He reported there were a thousand state champion patches found in a bag received from Marie. We will not need to order patches for some time.

Publicity Officer

Larry Readal was absent-No report.

Hunting Vice President

Larry Readal was absent-No report.

Tournament Committee

We still have no chairperson and no committee members.

Banquet Committee

A meeting will be scheduled in the coming weeks. Shannon will get with American Vets and reserve the banquet hall.

Secretary/Treasurer

VBA has a total of 722 members with 587 as head of household. Bank balance as of September 14, 2023 is 23,060.02 Expenses for the quarter were 1,678.22.

President

Shannon Nesselrodt reported VBA STILL DOES NOT HAVE A Recording Secretary.

Rob Pecora brought the Recording Secretary's notebook of past minutes and turned over the Secretary/Treasurer until someone takes the position.

Jim and Lowell will get all the details of the Lancaster style shoot hashed out and published. It was determined the shoot would be open to anyone.

There was discussion on the bylaw change to Pg.11 Section 15.1.6.

Since that change has already been voted on, the proposed addition will have to be done through an amended motion.

Some discussion was had regarding the proposed bylaw changes to the VBA Constitution to be in line with NFAA. NFAA has only one rep from each state and VBA would need to send a representative to the NFAA meetings.

As an organization, VBA could make motions to change or add to the NFAA constitution.

VFAA has been unresponsive and has done nothing to further the sport in years.

A motion to change VBA bylaws will have to wait to see if we get accepted by NFAA.

The Outdoor League belt buckle was awarded to Daryl Diahel and the second-place certificate was awarded to Josh Saufley. Third place was Melissa Miller, but she was not at the meeting.

New Business

Shannon Nesselrodt is involved with the Youth Archery Initiation Training for youth events. VBA will cover the cost of equipment and classes.

He wants to have a VBA sponsored "Big Buck" contest on social media and recognize the harvests made by the club members.

Danny committed that the VBA members need to submit more awards applications for their harvest. Jim Little requested permission to order the necessary awards for next year. A vote was taken by show of hands and all agreed to the order.

Jim stated he needed someone to send him a picture of the plaque so that he could get the ones from last year corrected.

Jim Little made a motion to make the required NFAA Indoor Shoot a separate shoot on the schedule, Terry Balowe seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously by show of hands.

If the clubs want to be NFAA, they will have to have five head of household members. The charter fee is 35.00 and VBA charter fee is 25.00.

Prince William Archers motioned to remove the outdoor classification on page 30-31 of the VBA Bylaws, Rob Pecora seconded, and motion will be an agenda item for January meeting.

Shannon Nesselrodt wants to give away all the old VBA stickers and order new stickers to give out with membership. There were no objections.

Shannon is hopeful to get someone like Jason Miller from DWR for the speaker at the March banquet. Shannon would like all the clubs to send him their club logo.

The indoor league should start mid-January and the belt buckle needs to be ordered. It was noted that a count should be taken of the shirts and hats before they are passed around for sale at different clubs.

VBA website needs to be redone. Rob Pecora suggested Pat Donavon. Danny said he would help in conversation only. Shannon will get with Larry and Tim. Shannon would like to get a Website Committee together the first of the year.

There was discussion about recordkeeping, and it was decided we did not need to keep the scorecards since no one sends in the shoot scores anymore. We will pull out the OGF members and file with the OGF records. All other records should be kept for five years.

The computer software needs to be updated and so does the computer. Terry Balowe motioned VBA allocates 2500.00 to IT updates and to be done by January 1, 2024. BOR seconded and a vote was taken by show of hands and passed unanimously.

The next meeting of VBA will be in person on January 14, 2024, at 8:30 AM at Bowhunters of Rockingham.

BOR motioned the meeting be adjourned and Belvoir seconded, and the regular meeting was adjourned at 10:40 AM.



Barr Hunting with Hound Doggs

This is a story of how I went barr hunting with hound doggs in the mountains of Virginia for the first time. So, lend me your ear and listen up.

It was a few years back in a county far away (Bland, Virginia), with high mountains and deep hollers filled with tall oaks and mountain laurel so thick the sun has trouble getting in...and spring water so pure that it can still be drank straight from the ground.

It all began in late December, early one morning. I arose well before dawn, put on hunting clothes (forgetting that it is 17 below zero), grab up my hunting gear and supplies, and jump into my truck. I drive like crazy to a place I've never been before, hoping and praying I don't get lost. Thankfully, I arrived at the meeting place on time. I think to myself, "boy, it's cold!" My hunting buddy and barr guide is an hour late. We then head into the wood to hunt. We got to the top of the mountain and meet other hunters with doggs (note to self: wear more clothes next time, it's 17 degrees). We release the hounds and hope the Lord is watching out for us (well, maybe not). The doggs tear out of the ridge and don't look back. There's a barr in a tree three miles out and it's on private land. Oh well. By the magic of cell phones, I get a picture of a very large barr laying on a limb, laughing at the hounds and the hunters. We go to meet the doggs and the owner is down the mountain on the other side. We are going to learn to really hunt now…hunting for a great big, wide spot in the road…hunt for a stove and grub in a truck full of hunting stuff. Finally find the stove and barr hunting grub (hot dogs and fixins), eat four or five and go home until the next time.

One week later (the day before Christmas), I am now a seasoned hound hunter. I've got it all figured out...what could possibly go wrong? I arose once again before dawn and put on my hunting clothes...enough for another 17-degree day...but it wasn't that cold today. I grab my gear and jump in the truck. I drive like crazy to the new, top secret pick-up spot (the VFW parking lot) and make it in one piece. I quietly head into barr country with five trucks and twice as many hounds. We arrive silently and unheard (LOL) to the top of the world. We await the break of dawn as the sun arises. It's a quiet, cool, nice day...thankfully not 17 degrees. Once again, we release the hounds and pray the Lord is looking out for us. This time, He is! The doggs hit a barr out the mountain. They are coming out way and run the barr right by us. We see the chase for half a mile or so. Now, the Lord looks the other way. They doggs run the barr down the mountain and over the hill into a big hollow and over the next ridge and tree. Now, I'm looking down into a wooded Grand Canyon thinking this might not be the sport for a 300 lb. fat man with bad knees. I'm also thinking that maybe I should not have eaten all of those hot dogs during the last hunt. Still, the Lord has not forsaken me as I thought. Larry says "get in the truck." Back the mountain we go, at the speed of sound backwards, around hair pin turns on loose gravel and arrive in one piece. Above and on the same ridge as the hounds and barr, off we go...a fat man in 17-degree weather clothes on a 35-degree day. Halfway there, I'm sweating like a pig, sucking wind. Off come most of the clothes. Come to the tree and the big barr is about 20 feet up. After a few pics and a wind break, it's time to find a good angle and open shot with no limbs in the way.

Now I make a big mistake. I shoot the barr...nice shot pass through. The barr wobbles a little and out it comes, crashing to the ground and not moving. The doggs bark and sniff the barr. He's dead. Now, the real story starts.

The misery of barr hunting in the mountains begins. How to get a barr out of the mountains and not die trying...Well, that's a story in itself for another day.

All humor aside, this was a great hunt with good friends and great hounds men.

Laugh hard, hunt harder, enjoy all you do!







ORDER OF THE GOLDEN FEATHER NOMINATIONS DUE IN MARCH

The VBA Order of the Golden Feather was created to honor those persons who have given unselfishly of their time and talents toward the betterment of archery and archers. Recipients are persons who possess the virtues of sportsmanship, character, morals, integrity and friendship. As a reflection of the substance for membership, only 86 people have been elected to the Order in the past 78 years.

To be qualified, a candidate must be member in good standing of the VBA at the time of nomination, must have a minimum of ten successive years' membership in the VBA and must be sponsored by three VBA members of good standing or by a VBA Club.

This article is a reminder that candidates must be submitted to the Board of Directors at the March meeting for this year. Nominations must be in writing and be signed by sponsoring individuals or a Club officer. Successful nominees have always performed duties or had an impact outside their immediate club.

Details can be found in Article 16 of the VBA By-Laws.
